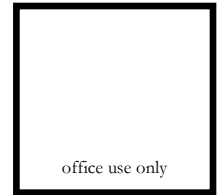

Planning Your Quilt

Quilt entries of all sizes are welcome. Buyers are generally looking for standard sized bed quilts. Approximate quilt sizes are:

*twin (66"x88") * full (81"x96")
* queen (90"x102") * king (102"x108")

Tied, machine-quilted, hand-quilted and hand stitched quilts are all welcomed. Buyers go for contemporary as well as traditional designs with coordinated colors, finished edges, and detailed stitching or appliques.

Many of our buyers are quilt lovers but not necessarily quilt makers. They are looking for "quilts that show heart". They want to know the name of the design, who made the quilt, why the design was chosen, or special fabrics used. Any information you have to share (briefly, please) will be valued and appreciated along with the quilt. It can be interesting to include the number of quilters and total hours involved in making your entry.

The quilt becomes more valuable if you affix a permanent label (a "pedigree") to the back with your name or the name of the quilting group, the quilt pattern, and the words "2017 Camp Okoboji Quilt Auction". A simple label can be hand-printed with a permanent marker and attached.

Your creativity and workmanship are greatly appreciated!

Delivering Your Quilt

Unless a special arrangement has been made, quilts should be received at the Camp Office by **May 28th, 2018** in order to be photographed, processed, and posted in the on-line Quilt Catalog.
